1-8 relating to cancellation or suspension of an alcoholic beverage
1-9 license or permit.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 11.65, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 11.65. NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OR SUSPENSION. (a) A
1-14 notice of cancellation or suspension of a license or permit shall be
1-15 given to the licensee or permittee as provided by Section 2001.142,
1-16 Government Code [personally or by registered or certified mail].

1-17 (b) Cancellation or suspension is final and effective as
1-18 provided by Section 2001.144, Government Code [takes effect when
1-19 the notice is given or delivered].

1-20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-21 to notice of a cancellation or suspension of an alcoholic beverage
1-22 license or permit given on or after the effective date of this Act.
1-23 A notice given before the effective date of this Act is governed by
1-24 the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is
1-25 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
