4	SECTION 1. Section 382.055, Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsections (e-1),
6	(e-2), and (e-3) to read as follows:
7	(e) The commission shall impose as a condition for renewal
8	of a preconstruction permit only those requirements the commission
9	determines to be economically reasonable and technically
10	practicable considering the age of the facility and the effect of
11	its emissions on the surrounding area.
12	<u>(e-1)</u> The commission may not impose requirements <u>under</u>
13	Subsection (e) more stringent than those of the existing permit
14	unless the commission determines that:
15	(1) the requirements are necessary to avoid a
16	condition of air pollution <u>;</u>
17	(2) the requirements are necessary [or] to ensure
18	compliance with otherwise applicable federal or state air quality
19	control requirements <u>; or</u>
20	(3) the facility is permitted to emit an air
21	contaminant that has the potential to produce adverse health
22	effects or odors and is listed on the commission's air pollutant
23	watch list for a specified geographic area in which the facility is
24	located.

1 <u>(e-2) The authority of the commission under Subsection</u> 2 <u>(e-1)(3) to impose a more stringent requirement on a facility</u> 3 <u>applies only to requirements applicable to an air contaminant that</u> 4 <u>is listed on the air pollutant watch list for the specific</u> 5 <u>geographic area in which the facility is located.</u>

6 <u>(e-3)</u> The commission may not impose requirements <u>under</u> 7 <u>Subsection (e)</u> less stringent than those of the existing permit 8 unless the commission determines that a proposed change will meet 9 the requirements of Sections 382.0518 and 382.0541.

SECTION 2. Section 382.055(e-1), Health and Safety Code, as 10 added by this Act, applies only to an application for a 11 preconstruction permit renewal that is submitted to the Texas 12 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date 13 of this Act. A preconstruction permit renewal application that is 14 15 submitted to the commission before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted, 16 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 17

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
