- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 471.007(a) and (c), Transportation
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A railway company commits an offense if:
- 8 <u>(1)</u> a train of the railway company obstructs for more
- 9 than 10 minutes a street, railroad crossing, or public highway; and
- 10 (2) as a result, an authorized emergency vehicle, as
- 11 defined by Section 541.201, is prevented from taking the most
- 12 direct route to an emergency.
- 13 (c) An officer charging a railway company for an offense
- 14 under this section shall prepare in duplicate a citation to appear
- in court and deliver [attach] one copy of the citation to [the train
- 16 or deliver the copy to an employee or other agent of the railway
- 17 company. The citation must show:
- 18 (1) the name of the railway company;
- 19 (2) the offense charged; and
- 20 (3) the time and place that a representative of the
- 21 railway company is to appear in court.
- 22 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 24 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before

- 1 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 2 before that date.
- 3 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 4 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 5 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
