- 6 SECTION 1. Section 522.072, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (d) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) An employer may not knowingly permit a person to drive a
- 10 commercial motor vehicle during a period in which:
- 11 (1) the person:
- 12  $\underline{\text{(A)}}$  [\frac{(1)}{}] has been denied the privilege of
- 13 driving a commercial motor vehicle;
- (B)  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  is disqualified from driving a
- 15 commercial motor vehicle;
- (C)  $[\frac{3}{3}]$  is subject to an out-of-service order
- 17 in a state; or
- 18  $\underline{\text{(D)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(4)}}{\text{)}}$ ] has more than one commercial driver's
- 19 license, except during the 10-day period beginning on the date the
- 20 person is issued a driver's license; or
- 21 (2) the employer is subject to an out-of-service order
- that affects the driver or the vehicle.
- 23 (b-1) An employer who violates Subsection (a) or (b) commits
- 24 an offense. An offense under this subsection is a Class B

- 2 (d) For purposes of Subsections (a)(1)(C) and (2),
- 3 "commercial motor vehicle" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 4 644.001.
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 7 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 9 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 10 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 11 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 12 committed before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
