A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a report to the legislature by the division of workers'
3 compensation of the Texas Department of Insurance of certain
4 information regarding employers not covered by workers'
5 compensation insurance.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 402, Labor Code, is
8 amended by adding Section 402.0666 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 402.0666. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE REGARDING CERTAIN
10 EMPLOYERS. (a) The division shall report annually to the
11 legislature any information collected by the division regarding:

12 (1) the compliance of employers who do not obtain or
13 otherwise provide workers' compensation insurance coverage with
14 any notice requirements imposed by Subchapter A, Chapter 406;

15 (2) any administrative penalties assessed under this
16 subtitle or rules adopted under this subtitle against employers
17 described by Subdivision (1) for failure to comply with the notice
18 requirements;

19 (3) the compliance of employers who do not obtain or
20 otherwise provide workers' compensation insurance coverage with
21 the reporting requirements of Section 411.032; and

22 (4) any administrative penalties assessed under
23 Section 411.032 against an employer described by Subdivision (3)
24 for failure to comply with the reporting requirements.

1 (b) The division may make the report required under
2 Subsection (a) as part of the department's annual report under
3 Section 32.021, Insurance Code, or as a separate report.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
