A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to restricting students who fail to perform satisfactorily
- 3 on state-administered assessment instruments from participating in
- 4 extracurricular activities.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 33.081, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (c) A student who is enrolled in a school district in this
- 10 state or who participates in a University Interscholastic League
- 11 competition shall be suspended from participation in any
- 12 extracurricular activity sponsored or sanctioned by the school
- 13 district or the University Interscholastic League after a grade
- 14 evaluation period in which the student received a grade lower than
- the equivalent of 70 on a scale of 100 in any academic class other
- 16 than an identified honors or advanced class. A suspension
- 17 continues for at least three school weeks and is not removed during
- 18 the school year until the conditions of Subsection (d) are met. A
- 19 suspension under this subsection does not last beyond the end of a
- 20 school year. For purposes of this subsection, "grade evaluation
- 21 period" means:
- 22 (1) the six-week grade reporting period; or
- 23 (2) the first six weeks of a semester and each grade
- 24 reporting period thereafter, in the case of a district with a grade

- 1 reporting period longer than six weeks.
- 2 (d-1) A student who is enrolled in a school district in this
- 3 state or who participates in a University Interscholastic League
- 4 competition shall be suspended from participation in any
- 5 extracurricular activity sponsored or sanctioned by the school
- 6 district or the University Interscholastic League for the first six
- 7 weeks of the school year following a school year in which the
- 8 student did not perform satisfactorily on an assessment instrument
- 9 administered under Section 39.023(a), (c), or (1) any of the times
- 10 that the particular assessment instrument was administered to the
- 11 student.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 33.081(d-1), Education Code, as added by
- this Act, applies beginning with the 2008-2009 school year based on
- 14 student performance on an assessment instrument administered under
- 15 Section 39.023(a), (c), or (l), Education Code, during the
- 16 2007-2008 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
