- 17 governmental body that concerns the location of an alarm system,
- 18 the name of the occupant of an alarm system location, or the type of

- (b) Information described by Subsection (a) may be used by

- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act by the

- 5 an ordinance in effect on the effective date of this Act or proposed
- 6 for adoption on or after that date.
