1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to certain security technology at unmanned teller
1-9 machines.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 59.310, Finance Code, is amended by
1-12 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

1-13 (b-1) The rules may provide for a system that enhances
1-14 customer security, taking into account emerging technologies, the
1-15 availability of networks to exchange information, and the potential
1-16 compliance costs for financial institutions and other unmanned
1-17 teller machine service providers.

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
