(b) It is an exception to the application of Subsection (a) 13 14 that the person: (1) was driving a motor vehicle owned or under the 15 16 control of the authority and was authorized to drive the vehicle on the designated right-of-way; or 17 18 (2) was driving an authorized emergency vehicle, as defined by Section 541.201, and responding to a call. 19 (c) Subsection (a) may be enforced by any peace officer 20 21 listed in Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, in whose
