- 1 (3) [(2)] knowing the character and content of the 2 photograph, [ex] recording, broadcast, or transmission, promotes a 3 photograph, [ex visual] recording, broadcast, or transmission 4 described by Subdivision (1) or (2).
- (e) For purposes of Subsection (b)(2), a sign or signs

 posted indicating that the person is being photographed or that a

 visual image of the person is being recorded, broadcast, or

 transmitted is not sufficient to establish the person's consent

 under that subdivision.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 12 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 13 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the 14 15 purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 16 committed before that date. 17
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
