- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 562, Occupations Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 562.0141 to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 562.0141. SELECTION OF ANTIEPILEPTIC AND ANTISEIZURE 8 DRUGS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a pharmacist may not dispense a drug for the treatment of epilepsy or for the 9 treatment or prevention of seizures unless the drug is the specific 10 formulation and manufactured by the specific manufacturer that is
- 12 prescribed by the patient's physician.
- 13 (b) A pharmacist may substitute a drug product that is
- 14 generically equivalent for the treatment of epilepsy or for the
- treatment or prevention of seizures if, before making the 15
- substitution, the pharmacist obtains a signed authorization from 16
- the prescribing physician. 17

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 18
