- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 25.082(b) and (c), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The board of trustees of each school district shall
- 8 require students <u>and teachers</u>, once during each school day at each
- 9 school in the district, to recite:
- 10 (1) the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag
- 11 in accordance with 4 U.S.C. Section 4, and its subsequent
- 12 amendments; and
- 13 (2) the pledge of allegiance to the state flag in
- 14 accordance with Subchapter C, Chapter 3100, Government Code.
- 15 (c) A [On written request from a student's parent or
- 16 guardian, a school district shall excuse [the student] from
- 17 reciting a pledge of allegiance under Subsection (b):
- 18 <u>(1) a student if the student's parent or guardian</u>
- 19 provides a written request; or
- 20 (2) a teacher if the teacher provides a written
- 21 <u>request</u>.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
