  other responsible person who has a proper interest in the patient's

  welfare and who receives no remuneration, except for actual and

  necessary expenses];
- 15 (2) the facility administrator of the designated 16 mental health facility, <u>unless</u> [<u>if</u>] the administrator notifies the 17 court that facility personnel are <u>not</u> available to transport the 18 patient;
- 19 (3) [a special officer for mental health assignment 20 certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code;
- 21 [<del>(4)</del>] a representative of the local mental health 22 authority, who shall be reimbursed by the county;
- 23 <u>(4) a relative or other responsible person who has a</u> 24 proper interest in the patient's welfare and who receives no

- 1 remuneration, except for actual and necessary expenses; or
- 2 (5) the sheriff or constable  $[ \frac{1}{7}$  if no person is
- 3 available under Subdivision (1), (2), (3), or (4)].
