A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the sales and use tax on certain pharmaceutical
- 3 biotechnology cleanrooms and equipment.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.318(b), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) The exemption includes:
- 8 (1) chemicals, catalysts, and other materials that are
- 9 used during a manufacturing, processing, or fabrication operation
- 10 to produce or induce a chemical or physical change, to remove
- impurities, or to make the product more marketable;
- 12 (2) semiconductor fabrication cleanrooms and
- 13 equipment; and
- 14 (3) pharmaceutical biotechnology cleanrooms and
- 15 equipment that are installed as part of the construction of a new
- 16 facility [with a value of at least \$150 million and] on which
- 17 construction began after July 1, 2003[, and before August 31,
- 18 $\frac{2004}{1}$.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 20 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 21 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 22 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 23 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 24 the liability for those taxes.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007, if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that date,

this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
