- 16 (4) a person specified by a governor's proclamation,

- 19 (5) a person specified by a concurrent resolution
- 20 adopted by the legislature, subject to review and approval by the

- 22 (6) a person specified by order of the committee under

- 24 (7) an honorably retired officer of the Texas Rangers

- 1 who served at least 12 years as an officer or an officer of the Texas
- 2 Rangers who has either served at least 12 years as a Texas Ranger or
- 3 <u>died in the line of duty</u>.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
