- (2) "Permit fee" means an assessment, fee, cost, or 14 charge imposed by a political subdivision on a person seeking to 15

- (4) "Regulatory agency" means the governing body or a 20

Sec. 247.002. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE PERMIT FEE. 24

- 1 (a) A regulatory agency may impose a permit fee only if the agency
- 2 complies with this chapter and only in the amount necessary to
- 3 compensate the regulatory agency for the costs to review, process,
- 4 and issue the permit for which the fee is imposed.
- 5 (b) A fee collected by a regulatory agency for a permit may
- 6 not be used for a purpose other than to pay the costs of reviewing,
- 7 processing, and issuing the permit. Indirect costs of reviewing,
- 8 processing, and issuing a permit in an amount not to exceed 15
- 9 percent of the direct costs of those activities may be included in
- 10 calculating the costs under this subsection.
