1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to an inspection performed by a plumbing inspector or
1-11 qualified plumbing inspection business for a political
1-12 subdivision.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Section 1301.255(e), Occupations Code, is
1-15 amended to read as follows:

1-16 (e) Plumbing installed in compliance with a code adopted
1-17 under Subsection (a), (b), or (d) must be inspected by a plumbing
1-18 inspector. To perform the inspection, the political subdivision
1-19 may contract with any plumbing inspector or qualified plumbing
1-20 inspection business, as determined by the political subdivision,
1-21 that is paid directly by the political subdivision.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
