- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 62.007(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall
- 9 establish a risk assessment review committee composed of at least
- 10 seven members, each of whom serves on the review committee in
- 11 addition to the member's other employment-related duties. The
- 12 review committee, to the extent feasible, must include at least:
- 13 (1) one member having experience in law enforcement;
- 14 (2) one member having experience working with juvenile
- 15 sex offenders;
- 16 (3) one member having experience as a sex offender
- 17 treatment provider;
- 18 (4) one member having experience working with victims
- 19 of sex offenses;
- 20 (5) the executive director of the Council on Sex
- 21 Offender Treatment or the executive director's designee; and
- 22 (6) one sex offender treatment provider registered
- 23 under Chapter 110, Occupations Code, and selected by the executive
- 24 director of the Council on Sex Offender Treatment to serve on the

- 1 review committee.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
