- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 152, Human Resources Code,
- is amended by adding Section 152.0015 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 152.0015. COMPOSITION OF BOARD. (a) Each juvenile
- 7 board must include:
- 8 (1) a justice of the peace from the county served by
- 9 the juvenile board, selected by majority vote of all the justices of
- 10 the peace of the county; and
- 11 (2) a judge of a municipal court of a municipality
- 12 located in the county served by the juvenile board, selected by
- 13 majority vote of all the municipal judges of the municipalities
- 14 located in the county.
- 15 (b) A justice of the peace and judge of a municipal court
- serving on a juvenile board solely because of this section serve as
- 17 nonvoting members and may not receive any compensation for their
- 18 <u>service on the board.</u>
- (c) Notwithstanding Section 152.0001(b), to the extent of a
- 20 conflict between this section and a law applicable to the
- 21 composition of a specific juvenile board, this section prevails.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 152.0032, Human Resources Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 152.0032. COMPOSITION OF JUVENILE BOARD. (a) The

- 1 juvenile board is composed of:
- 2 <u>(1)</u> the county judge <u>of the county served by the</u>
- 3 juvenile board;[-
- 4 (2) the district judges in the county;
- 5 (3) a justice of the peace of the county, selected by
- 6 majority vote of all the justices of the peace of the county;
- 7 (4) a judge of a municipal court of a municipality
- 8 <u>located</u> in the county, selected by majority vote of all the
- 9 municipal judges of the municipalities located in the county; $[\tau]$
- 10 and
- 11 $\underline{\text{(5)}}$ the judges of any statutory courts designated as a
- 12 juvenile court in the county.
- 13 (b) A justice of the peace and judge of a municipal court
- 14 serving on a juvenile board solely because of Subsection (a)(3) or
- 15 (4) serve as nonvoting members and may not receive any compensation
- for their service on the board, notwithstanding Section 152.0034.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 152.0051, Human Resources Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 152.0051. COMPOSITION OF JUVENILE BOARD. (a) The
- 20 juvenile board of a county that has a family district court is
- 21 composed of:
- 22 (1) the county judge of the county served by the
- 23 juvenile board;
- 24 (2) the judge of each family district court in the
- 25 county;
- 26 (3) the judge of each other district court in the

- 1 (4) a justice of the peace of the county, selected by
- 2 majority vote of all the justices of the peace of the county;
- 3 (5) a judge of a municipal court of a municipality
- 4 located in the county, selected by majority vote of all the

- 6 $\underline{(6)}$ [$\frac{(4)}{(4)}$] the judge of each other court in the county
- 7 that has jurisdiction over juvenile matters.
- 8 (b) A justice of the peace and judge of a municipal court
- 9 serving on a juvenile board solely because of Subsection (a)(4) or
- 10 (5) serve as nonvoting members and may not receive any compensation
- for their service on the board, notwithstanding Section 152.0053.
- 12 SECTION 4. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply to
- 13 each juvenile board created under Chapter 152, Human Resources
- 14 Code, regardless of whether the juvenile board is created before,
- on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 (b) As soon as possible after the effective date of this
- 17 Act, the commissioners court of each county in this state that is
- 18 served by a juvenile board on that date shall ensure that the
- 19 composition of the juvenile board conforms to the requirements of
- 20 Section 152.0015, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act, or
- 21 Section 152.0032 or 152.0051, Human Resources Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, as applicable.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect October 1, 2007.
