A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of an online volunteer fire department
3	registry by the Texas Forest Service.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 614, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter H to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER H. ONLINE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT REGISTRY
8	Sec. 614.151. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:

- 9 (1) "Part-paid fire department" means a fire
 10 department operated by its members, some of whom are volunteers and
 11 not more than 20 of whom are paid.
- 12 <u>(2) "Service" means the Texas Forest Service of The</u>
 13 Texas A&M University System.
- (3) "Volunteer fire department" means a fire department operated by its members, including a part-paid fire department, that is operated on a not-for-profit basis, including a department that is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, by being listed as an exempt organization in Section 501(c)(3) of that code.
- 20 <u>Sec. 614.152. ADMINISTRATION OF ONLINE VOLUNTEER FIRE</u>
 21 <u>DEPARTMENT REGISTRY. The service shall:</u>
- (1) establish and maintain an online registry of volunteer fire departments located in this state that is accessible to members of the public; and

1	(2) prescribe procedures necessary to implement this
2	subchapter.
3	Sec. 614.153. REGISTRATION REQUIRED. (a) Each volunteer
4	fire department in this state shall register with the service by
5	submitting to the service:
6	(1) an application for registration under Section
7	614.154; and
8	(2) the registration fee in the amount set by the
9	service.
10	(b) A volunteer fire department in this state may not engage
11	in firefighting activities involving a regional emergency incident
12	for which the service provides coordination unless the department
13	maintains a current registration with the service under this
14	subchapter.
15	Sec. 614.154. APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION. (a) An
16	application for registration must contain:
17	(1) the name of the volunteer fire department;
18	(2) the physical address of the volunteer fire
19	<pre>department;</pre>
20	(3) the mailing address of the volunteer fire
21	<pre>department;</pre>
22	(4) the number of volunteer firefighters and any other
23	personnel affiliated with the volunteer fire department;
24	(5) the name, address, and certification status under
25	Section 419.071 of each volunteer firefighter and any other
26	personnel affiliated with the volunteer fire department; and
27	(6) an itemized list of all firefighting equipment

- 1 used by the volunteer fire department for fire protection purposes.
- 2 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a volunteer fire
- 3 <u>department must submit an application online.</u>
- (c) A volunteer fire department may apply for a waiver of
- 5 the online registration requirement by submitting a written request
- 6 to the service for a written registration application.
- 7 <u>Sec. 614.155.</u> RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. A volunteer fire
- 8 department shall renew the department's registration annually by
- 9 filing a renewal application for registration and paying the
- 10 registration renewal fee in a manner prescribed by the service.
- 11 Sec. 614.156. REGISTRATION AND REGISTRATION RENEWAL
- 12 FEES. The service shall set a reasonable registration fee and
- 13 registration renewal fee in an amount designed to cover the costs of
- 14 administering this subchapter.
- Sec. 614.157. PUBLIC INFORMATION. Information submitted
- to the service in an application for registration or for renewal of
- 17 registration is public information.
- 18 SECTION 2. The Texas Forest Service of The Texas A&M
- 19 University System shall establish the online registry required by
- 20 Section 614.152, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 21 than January 1, 2008.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
