BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 45, Government Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 45.125 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 45.125. BROWN COUNTY. The county attorney of Brown 8 County or the Commissioners Court of Brown County may accept gifts or grants from any individual, partnership, corporation, trust, 9 foundation, association, or governmental entity for the purpose of 10 financing or assisting the operation of the office of county 11 12 attorney in Brown County. The county attorney shall account for and 13 report to the county auditor all gifts and grants accepted under 14 this <u>section</u>. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18
