1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to gifts and grants for financing or assisting the
1-9 operation of the office of county attorney in Brown County.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 45, Government Code, is
1-12 amended by adding Section 45.125 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 45.125. BROWN COUNTY. The county attorney of Brown
1-14 County or the Commissioners Court of Brown County may accept gifts
1-15 or grants from any individual, partnership, corporation, trust,
1-16 foundation, association, or governmental entity for the purpose of
1-17 financing or assisting the operation of the office of county
1-18 attorney in Brown County. The county attorney shall account for and
1-19 report to the county auditor all gifts and grants accepted under
1-20 this section.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
