- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 779.005, Health and Safety Code, is 4
- 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 779.005. NOTIFYING 9-1-1 SERVICE ANSWERING POINT
- [LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER]. (a) When a person or 7 8 entity acquires an automated external defibrillator, the person or
- entity shall notify the public safety answering point that answers 9
- 9-1-1 emergency calls for the area in which the defibrillator is 10
- located [local emergency medical services provider] of the 11
- 12 existence and precise $[\tau]$ location $[\tau]$ and type of the automated
- external defibrillator. 13
- 14 (b) A person or entity shall notify the public safety
- answering point if the person or entity changes the location of or 15
- 16 removes any automated external defibrillator.
- (c) A person or entity shall provide the notification under 17
- Subsection (a) or (b) not later than the 30th day after the date the 18
- person or entity acquires, changes the location of, or removes an 19
- automated external defibrillator. 20
- 21 (d) A public safety answering point shall develop and
- 22 implement a system to receive, record, and update the information
- 23 in Subsections (a) and (b).
- 24 (e) If a person calls a public safety answering point to

- 1 report a potential cardiac arrest emergency, the answering point
- 2 shall tell the caller the location nearest to the caller of an
- 3 automated external defibrillator.
- 4 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 33.088 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 33.088. AVAILABILITY OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL
- 7 DEFIBRILLATOR. (a) Each school district shall make available a
- 8 sufficient number of automated external defibrillators, as defined
- 9 by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, to reasonably cover
- 10 <u>each area of the campus of each school in the district.</u>
- 11 (b) A school district shall ensure that information
- 12 regarding the purpose and locations on campus of automated external
- 13 defibrillators is reasonably available to each employee and
- 14 student.
- (c) A school district shall store an automated external
- 16 defibrillator in a location from which the defibrillator may be
- 17 quickly and easily accessed.
- 18 (d) A school district shall post a conspicuous sign near
- 19 each automated external defibrillator that indicates the presence
- 20 and location of the defibrillator.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 779.006, Health and Safety Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 779.006. <u>LIMITATION ON</u> LIABILITY [EXEMPTION]. (a)
- 24 The following persons [prescribing physician who authorizes the
- 25 acquisition of an automated external defibrillator in accordance
- 26 with this chapter, a person or entity that provides approved
- 27 training in the use of an automated external defibrillator in

- 1 accordance with this chapter, and the person or entity that
- 2 acquires the automated external defibrillator and meets the
- 3 requirements of this chapter are not liable for civil damages
- 4 arising out of conduct relating to preparing for and responding to a
- 5 suspected sudden cardiac arrest emergency [for such prescription,
- 6 training, or acquisition] unless the conduct is wilfully or
- 7 wantonly negligent:
- 8 (1) a person that acquires an automated external
- 9 defibrillator;
- 10 <u>(2) a person that owns, manages, or is otherwise</u>
- 11 responsible for the premises on which an automated external
- 12 defibrillator is located;
- 13 (3) a person who retrieves an automated external
- 14 defibrillator in response to a perceived sudden cardiac arrest
- emergency;
- 16 (4) a person who uses, attempts to use, or fails to use
- 17 an automated external defibrillator in response to a perceived
- 18 sudden cardiac arrest emergency;
- 19 (5) a physician or other authorized person who issues
- 20 a prescription for the purchase of an automated external
- 21 <u>defibrillator</u>;
- 22 (6) a person that is involved with the design or
- 23 management of an automated external defibrillator program; and
- 24 (7) a person that provides instruction in the use of an
- 25 automated external defibrillator.
- 26 (b) The limitation on liability provided by this section is
- 27 not exclusive and a person may raise any other defense to liability

- 1 available under law. [Any person or entity that acquires an
- 2 automated external defibrillator and negligently fails to comply
- 3 with the requirements of this chapter is liable for civil damages
- 4 caused by such negligence.
- 5 SECTION 4. The following provisions of the Health and
- 6 Safety Code are repealed:
- 7 (1) Section 779.002;
- 8 (2) Section 779.003;
- 9 (3) Section 779.004;
- 10 (4) Section 779.007; and
- 11 (5) Section 779.008.
- 12 SECTION 5. A local emergency medical services provider
- 13 shall implement the system required by Section 779.005(d), Health
- and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later than the 180th day
- 15 following the effective date of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 6. Section 33.088, Education Code, as added by this
- 17 Act, applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
- 18 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
