## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the labeling requirements for drugs dispensed by

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 562.006(a), Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) The [Unless otherwise directed by the practitioner,
8	the] label on the dispensing container must indicate:
9	(1) the name, address, and telephone number of the
10	<pre>pharmacy;</pre>
11	(2) the date the prescription is dispensed;
12	(3) the name of the prescribing practitioner;
13	(4) the name of the patient, or if the drug was
14	prescribed for an animal, the species of the animal and the name of
15	the owner;
16	(5) instructions for use;
17	(6) the quantity dispensed;
18	(7) the date after which the prescription should not
19	be used, determined according to criteria established by board
20	<u>rule;</u>
21	(8) unless otherwise directed by the practitioner, the
22	actual drug dispensed, indicated by either:
23	(A) $[(1)]$ the brand name; or
24	(B) $[(2)$ ] if there is not a brand name, the

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- 1 generic name, the strength of the drug, and the name of the
- 2 manufacturer or distributor of the drug; and
- 3 (9) any other information required by board rule.
- 4 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2007, the Texas State
- 5 Board of Pharmacy shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
- 6 Section 562.006, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 562.006, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 8 this Act, applies only to a drug dispensed on or after January 1,
- 9 2008.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
