8 (e) Law enforcement records and files concerning a child may 9 be inspected <u>or copied</u> by a juvenile justice agency as that term is 10 defined by Section 58.101, [and] a criminal justice agency as that 11 term is defined by Section 411.082, Government Code, the child, and 12 <u>the child's parent or guardian</u>.

13 (j) Before a child or a child's parent or guardian may 14 inspect or copy a record or file concerning the child under 15 Subsection (e), the custodian of the record or file shall redact any 16 reference in the record or file to a juvenile suspect or offender 17 who is not the child. 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
