## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the issuance of a protective order for a victim of the

- 3 offense of sexual assault or aggravated sexual assault.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 7A.01(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person who is the victim of an offense under Section
- 8 22.011 or 22.021, Penal Code, a parent or guardian acting on behalf
- 9 of a person younger than 17 years of age who is the victim of such an
- 10 offense, or a prosecuting attorney acting on behalf of the victim
- 11 [person], may file an application for a protective order under this
- 12 chapter without regard to the relationship between the  $\underline{\text{victim}}$
- 13 [applicant] and the alleged offender.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 7A, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- amended by adding Article 7A.07 to read as follows:
- Art. 7A.07. DURATION OF PROTECTIVE ORDER. (a) A protective
- order issued under Article 7A.03 is effective for the duration of
- 18 the lives of the offender and victim, or for any shorter period
- 19 stated in the order. If a period is not stated in the order, the
- 20 order is effective until the second anniversary of the date the
- 21 <u>order was issued.</u>
- (b) Section 85.025, Family Code, does not apply to the
- 23 protective order.
- (c) A victim who is 17 years of age or older or a parent or

- 1 guardian acting on behalf of a victim who is younger than 17 years
- 2 of age may file at any time an application with the court to rescind
- 3 the protective order.
- 4 (d) If a person who is the subject of a protective order
- 5 issued under Article 7A.03 is confined or imprisoned on the date the
- 6 protective order is due to expire under Subsection (a), the period
- 7 for which the order is effective is extended, and the order expires
- 8 on the first anniversary of the date the person is released from
- 9 confinement or imprisonment.
- 10 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 11 protective order issued on or after the effective date of this Act
- on the basis of an offense committed before, on, or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act. A protective order issued before the
- 14 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 15 date the protective order was issued, and the former law is
- 16 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
