A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the penalty for being in violation of financial 3 responsibility requirements at the time of causing a motor vehicle 4 accident.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 601.191, Transportation Code, is amended 7 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as 8 follows:

9 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (c)<u>, (c-1)</u>, and (d), 10 an offense under this section is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine 11 of not less than \$175 or more than \$350.

12 (c-1) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this 13 section that the defendant was operating a motor vehicle in 14 violation of Section 601.051 at the time the defendant caused a 15 motor vehicle accident, the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.

16 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies 17 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this 18 Act. For the purposes of this section, an offense is committed 19 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense 20 occurs before that date.

(b) An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
