- 7 (a) A party may appeal an associate judge's report by filing
- 8 notice of appeal not later than the <u>seventh working</u> [third] day
- 9 after the date the party receives notice of the substance of the
- 10 associate judge's report as provided by Section 201.011.
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after
- 13 the effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child
- 14 relationship filed before that date is governed by the law in
- 15 effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law is
- 16 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
