- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 20A, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 20A.03 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 20A.03. UNLAWFUL TRANSPORT OF ILLEGAL ALIEN. (a) In
- 8 this section, "illegal alien" means a person who:
- 9 (1) is not a citizen or national of the United States;
- 10 and
- 11 (2) is unlawfully present in the United States
- 12 according to the terms of 8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.
- 13 (b) A person commits an offense if the person transports an
- 14 illegal alien in a manner that is designed to conceal the illegal
- 15 alien from local, state, or federal law enforcement authorities.
- (c) Except as otherwise provided by Subsection (d), an
- 17 offense under this section is a state jail felony.
- (d) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
- 19 degree if the offense is committed:
- 20 <u>(1)</u> for pecuniary benefit; or
- 21 (2) in a manner that creates a substantial likelihood
- 22 that the illegal alien will suffer bodily injury.
- (e) It is an exception to the application of this section
- 24 that the actor is related to the illegal alien within the third

- 1 degree of consanguinity or at the time of the offense within the
- 2 <u>third degree of affinity.</u>
- 3 (f) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 4 <u>also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the</u>
- 5 actor may be prosecuted under either section.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
