A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to health benefit plan coverage for a hospital stay 3 following mastectomy and certain related procedures. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 1357.052, Insurance Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 Sec. 1357.052. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. (a) 7 This subchapter applies only to a health benefit plan that: 8 provides benefits for medical or surgical expenses 9 (1)incurred as a result of a health condition, accident, or sickness, 10 11 including: 12 (A) an individual, group, blanket, or franchise 13 insurance policy or insurance agreement, a group hospital service 14 contract, or an individual or group evidence of coverage that is 15 offered by: (i) an insurance company; 16 (ii) a group hospital service corporation 17 operating under Chapter 842; 18 (iii) a fraternal benefit society operating 19 under Chapter 885; 20 21 (iv) a stipulated premium company operating under Chapter 884; or 22 (v) a health maintenance organization 23 operating under Chapter 843; and 24

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H.B. No. 2011 to the extent permitted by the Employee 1 (B) Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (29 U.S.C. Section 1001 et 2 seq.), a health benefit plan that is offered by: 3 4 (i) a multiple employer welfare arrangement 5 as defined by Section 3 of that Act; or 6 (ii) another analogous benefit 7 arrangement; 8 (2) is offered by an approved nonprofit health corporation that holds a certificate of authority under Chapter 9 10 844; or (3) provides coverage only for a specific disease or 11 12 condition or for hospitalization. (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a standard health 13 benefit plan provided under Chapter 1507 must provide the coverage 14 15 required by this subchapter. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 16 17 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2008. A health benefit plan that is 18 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2008, 19 is covered by the law in effect at the time the health benefit plan 20 21 was delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
