A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the design and installation of signs at certain
3	crosswalks used regularly by elderly pedestrians.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 544, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 544.0015 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 544.0015. SIGNAGE FOR CERTAIN CROSSWALKS. (a) The
8	manual adopted under Section 544.001 must include provisions for
9	the design and installation of warning signs to designate a marked
10	crosswalk that is used regularly by elderly pedestrians who:
11	(1) are unable to adequately judge when it is safe to
12	cross the roadway; or
13	(2) require a longer time to cross the roadway.
14	(b) The manual may not prohibit a local authority, in
15	connection with a roadway under its jurisdiction, from installing a
16	sign designed under Subsection (a) if the governing body of the
17	local authority determines that installation of the sign is:
18	(1) supported by an engineering and traffic
19	investigation; or
20	(2) in the best interest of or necessary for the
21	protection of elderly pedestrians who regularly use the marked
22	crosswalk.

(c) In connection with a roadway under the jurisdiction of a

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- 1 adult individuals who reside within 2,500 feet of a crosswalk
- 2 described by Subsection (a) requesting the installation of a
- 3 warning sign authorized by that subsection, the governing body of
- 4 the local authority shall direct that:
- 5 <u>(1) an engineering and traffic investigation be</u>
- 6 performed to evaluate the request; or
- 7 (2) the sign be placed at the crosswalk, if the
- 8 governing body determines that installation of the sign is in the
- 9 best interest of or necessary for the protection of elderly
- 10 pedestrians who regularly use the crosswalk.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 2, 2007.
