10	(1) "License" means a license, certificate, permit, or
11	other authorization issued by the department.
12	(2) "Victim of identity theft" means an individual who
13	has filed a criminal complaint alleging the commission of an
14	offense under Section 32.51, Penal Code, other than a person who is
15	convicted of an offense under Section 37.08, Penal Code, with
16	respect to that complaint.
17	(b) The department may abate or defer a mandatory suspension
18	or revocation of a license if the license holder presents evidence
19	acceptable to the department that:
20	(1) the license holder is the victim of identity
21	theft; and
22	(2) the person against whom a criminal complaint
23	alleging the commission of an offense under Section 32.51, Penal
24	Code, has been filed, and not the license holder, engaged in the act

## 1 or omission that mandates the suspension or revocation.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
