- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 104, Utilities Code, is
- 6 continued through Railroad Commission Sunset, 2013.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an application for a
- 8 tariff or rate schedule in relation to which a regulatory authority
- 9 has not issued a final order on the effective date of this Act. An
- 10 application in relation to which a regulatory authority has issued
- 11 a final order before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 12 the law in effect on the date the final order is issued, and that law
- is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
