- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 151.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 151.001. REFERRAL BY AGREEMENT. On agreement of the
- 7 parties, in civil or family law matters pending in a district court,
- 8 statutory probate court, or statutory county court, the judge in
- 9 whose court the case is pending shall [may] order referral of the
- 10 case as provided by this chapter and shall stay proceedings in the
- 11 judge's court pending the outcome of the trial. Any or all of the
- issues in the cases, whether an issue of fact or law, \underline{shall} [may] be
- 13 referred as agreed upon by the parties.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 151.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 15 Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a motion for referral
- of a case to a special judge that is made on or after the effective
- 17 date of this Act. A motion for referral made before the effective
- date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 19 referral was made, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
