A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the salary paid to certain employees of public schools.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 4 5 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsections (c-3) and 6 (c-4) to read as follows:

 - (c-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2007-2008 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of: (1) the monthly salary the employee would have received for the 2007-2008 school year under the district's salary schedule for the 2006-2007 school year, if that schedule had been in

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- 1 effect for the 2007-2008 school year, including any local
- 2 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
- 3 the employee would have received in the 2007-2008 school year; and
- (2) \$300.
- 5 (c-4) Subsection (c-3) and this subsection expire September
- 6 <u>1, 2008.</u>
- 7 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 8 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
- 9 employed by a school district in the 2007-2008 [2006-2007] school
- 10 year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,
- 11 entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the
- 12 employee received for the 2007-2008 [2006-2007] school year.
- SECTION 2. Section 22.107, Education Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 15 (a-1) In addition to the amount required by Subsection (a),
- 16 <u>a school district shall pay each full-time district employee, other</u>
- than an employee employed in a supervisory capacity or an employee
- 18 subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section 21.402, an
- amount at least equal to \$3,000.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 42.2518 to read as follows:
- 22 <u>Sec. 42.2518. ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST</u>
- 23 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A
- 24 school district, including a school district that is otherwise
- 25 ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state
- 26 aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the
- 27 product of \$3,000 multiplied by the sum of:

- 1 (1) the number of classroom teachers, full-time
- 2 librarians, full-time counselors certified under Subchapter B,
- 3 Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by the district
- 4 and entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402; and
- 5 (2) the number of full-time district employees, other
- 6 than employees employed in a supervisory capacity or employees
- 7 <u>subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section 21.402.</u>
- 8 (b) A school district that is required to take action under
- 9 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- 10 level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which
- 11 the district is entitled under this section, against the total
- 12 amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase
- 13 attendance credits.
- 14 (c) Funding to which a school district is entitled under
- this section does not affect the amount of state aid to which the
- district is entitled under Section 42.2516.
- 17 (d) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- is final and may not be appealed.
- 19 (e) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 20 section.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 22 school year.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
