2	relating to emission reduction strategies for greenhouse gases.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 382.0174 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 382.0174. EMISSION REDUCTION STRATEGIES FOR
7	GREENHOUSE GASES. (a) In this section, "greenhouse gas" includes
8	carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, hydrofluorocarbons,
9	perfluorocarbons, and sulfur hexafluoride.
LO	(b) Not later than December 31, 2008, the commission shall
L1	prepare and deliver to each member of the legislature a report
L2	including a list of strategies for reducing emissions of greenhouse
L3	gases in this state.
L4	(c) In preparing the list of emission reduction strategies,
L5	the commission:
L6	(1) may not include a strategy that may result in a
L7	financial cost to the state or consumers or businesses in this
L8	state; and
L9	(2) shall consider:
20	(A) any short-term or long-term net savings,
21	including life-cycle savings, to the state or to consumers or
22	businesses in this state that may result from the implementation of
23	a strategy; and
24	(B) strategies for reducing the emissions of

- 1 greenhouse gases that have been implemented in other states or
- 2 nations.
- 3 (d) In determining under Subsection (c) whether an emission
- 4 reduction strategy may result in a financial cost to the state or to
- 5 consumers or businesses in this state, the commission shall
- 6 consider:
- 7 (1) the total net costs that may occur over the life of
- 8 the strategy, as opposed to the short-term capital costs that may
- 9 result from the implementation of the strategy; and
- 10 (2) the total net costs that may occur across the
- 11 state, as opposed to the costs to a particular sector of the state
- or a particular group of consumers or businesses in this state.
- (e) The commission may appoint advisory committees to
- 14 assist the commission in identifying and evaluating greenhouse gas
- 15 <u>emission reduction strategies.</u>
- (f) Not later than June 1, 2009, the commission shall adopt
- 17 rules implementing each of the strategies in the report to the
- 18 extent that the implementation does not conflict with other state
- 19 law. The rules must require each strategy to become operational at
- the earliest practicable date and not later than June 1, 2010.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
