1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to police officers eligible to be certified to enforce
1-10 commercial motor vehicle safety standards.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(b), Transportation Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (b) A police officer of any of the following municipalities
1-15 is eligible to apply for certification under this section:

1-16 (1) a municipality with a population of 100,000 or
1-17 more;

1-18 (2) a municipality with a population of 60,000 or more
1-19 any part of which is located in:

1-20 (A) a county with a population of 750,000 or
1-21 more; and

1-22 (B) two or more counties with a combined
1-23 population of one million or more;

1-24 (3) a municipality with a population of 25,000 or more
1-25 any part of which is located in a county with a population of two
1-26 million or more;

1-27 (4) [~~3~~] a municipality with a population of less
1-28 than 25,000:

1-29 (A) any part of which is located in a county with
1-30 a population of 2.4 million; and

1-31 (B) that contains or is adjacent to an
1-32 international port; or

1-33 (5) [~~4~~] a municipality any part of which is located
1-34 in a county bordering the United Mexican States.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
