H.B. No. 2079

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to examinations for certain applicants for a license to
3 practice medicine.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 155.056, Occupations Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

7 (c) The limitation on examination attempts by an applicant
8 under Subsection (a) does not apply to an applicant who:

9 (1) is licensed and in good standing as a physician in
10 another state;

11 (2) has been licensed for at least five years; and

12 (3) does not hold a medical license in the other state
13 that has any restrictions, disciplinary orders, or probation.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
