A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating	to	the	wages	credited	to	an	individual	for	the	purpose	of

- 3 computing the individual's unemployment compensation benefits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 207.002, Labor Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
 - (a) An eligible individual who is totally unemployed in a benefit period is entitled to benefits for the benefit period at the rate of 1/25 of the wages received by the individual from employment by employers during that quarter in the individual's base period in which wages were highest. For purposes of this subsection, the wages received by the individual from employment by employers during the individual's base period include wages ordered to be paid to the individual by a final order of the commission under Chapter 61 that:
- 17 <u>(1) were due to be paid to the individual by an</u>
 18 employer during the individual's base period; and
- 19 <u>(2) will be credited to the date or dates on which the</u>
 20 payment of those wages was due.
- 21 <u>(a-1) The commission by rule shall determine the method of</u>
 22 <u>crediting wages to a particular quarter for purposes of Subsection</u>
 23 (a).
- 24 (a-2) The rate of benefits paid under this section may not

- 1 be more than the maximum weekly benefit amount computed under
- 2 Subsection (b) or less than the minimum weekly benefit amount
- 3 computed under Subsection (b) for each benefit period.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 207.004, Labor Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) The commission shall credit <u>as benefit wage credits</u>
- 8 during an individual's base period:
- 9 (1) [an individual's] wages the individual received
- 10 for employment from an employer during the individual's base
- 11 period; and
- 12 (2) wages ordered to be paid by a final order issued by
- 13 the commission under Chapter 61 that:
- 14 (A) were due to be paid by an employer during the
- individual's base period; and
- 16 (B) will be credited to the date or dates on which
- 17 the payment of those wages was due [as the individual's benefit wage
- 18 credits].
- 19 (a-1) The commission by rule shall determine the method of
- 20 crediting wages to an individual's base period for purposes of
- 21 <u>Subsection (a).</u>
- 22 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 eligibility for unemployment benefits based on an unemployment
- 24 compensation claim that is filed with the Texas Workforce
- 25 Commission on or after the effective date of this Act. A claim
- 26 filed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date
- 27 the claim was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for

- 1 that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
