1	AN ACT
2	relating to the information collected through the Public Education
3	Information Management System.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 42.006(d), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(d) The commissioner's rules must ensure that the Public
8	Education Information Management System <u>:</u>
9	(1) links student performance data to other related
10	information for purposes of efficient and effective allocation of
11	scarce school resources, to the extent practicable using existing
12	agency resources and appropriations <u>;</u>
13	(2) contains a transcript for each student that
14	records:
15	(A) the courses taken by the student and the
16	student's grades;
17	(B) the identification number of the student's
18	teacher in each class or in each course in a major subject area, as
19	applicable;
20	(C) the student's scores on national assessment
21	instruments administered by the state or school district;
22	(D) any disciplinary warnings given and
23	disciplinary actions taken; and
24	(E) any participation by the student in a magnet

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1	school program that has criteria for admission other than the order
2	in which students' applications for admission are received or an
3	admissions lottery; and
4	(3) contains a record of each teacher's training,
5	experience, and continuing education and professional development
6	activities, including:
7	(A) the type of each certification held by the
8	<pre>teacher;</pre>
9	(B) the name of the educator preparation program
10	the teacher attended, the teacher's major field of postsecondary
11	study, the courses completed by the teacher, and the number of
12	semester credit hours and the overall grade the teacher earned in
13	each of those courses;
14	(C) the number of years of teaching experience in
15	specified grade levels or courses, as applicable, and any
16	experience in an occupation other than teaching and the number of
17	years of such experience; and
18	(D) the teacher's continuing education and
19	professional development activities, including the number of
20	instructional hours, type of instruction, instructor's name, name
21	of the entity providing the instruction, and date completed.
22	SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2007, the
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commissioner of education shall adopt rules requiring school districts and educator preparation programs in this state, including alternative teacher preparation programs, to provide through the Public Education Information Management System the applicable information required by Section 42.006(d), Education

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Code, as amended by this Act. Rules adopted under Section 42.006(d)(2)(B), Education Code, as added by this Act, must require a school district to provide information linking individual students to individual teachers beginning with:

5 (1) the 2002-2003 school year, if the district's 6 information is currently available in electronic form; or

7 (2) the 2007-2008 school year, if the district's
8 information from previous school years is not currently available
9 in electronic form.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
