- duty as a member of the United States military forces, the Texas

- SECTION 2. Section 46.004(c), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c) The commission shall waive the fee for a qualified
- 19 disabled veteran as defined by Section 42.012 and for a resident on
- 20 active duty as a member of the United States military forces, the
- 21 Texas Army National Guard, the Texas Air National Guard, or the
- 22 Texas State Guard.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
