- 18 (5) identify staff needed to implement the plan;
- 19 (6) set timelines for reaching the goals;
- 20 (7) measure progress toward the performance 21 objectives periodically to ensure that the plan is resulting in 22 academic improvement;
- 23 (8) include goals and methods for violence prevention 24 and intervention, dropout deterrence, and academic enhancement on

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1 that may include ongoing, research-based campus teacher 2 development programs that focus on: 3 (A) developing healthy self-esteem in students; 4 (B) nurturing the well-being of students; and 5 (C) creating a nurturing classroom environment; 6 and provide for a program to encourage parental 7 (9) 8 involvement at the campus that may include research-based classes and training in nurturing and providing positive discipline to a 9 child. 10 11 SECTION 2. Section 11.253(d), Education Code, as amended by this Act, applies to campus improvement plans beginning with campus 12 improvement plans for the 2008-2009 school year. 13

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
