1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to eligibility to serve as the executive director of the  
1-9 Teacher Retirement System of Texas.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 825.202(c), Government Code, is amended  
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 (c) To be eligible to serve as the executive director, a  
1-14 person must:

1-15 (1) be ~~[have been]~~ a citizen of the United States; and

1-16 (2) have executive ability and experience to carry out  
1-17 the duties of the office [this state for the three years immediately  
1-18 preceding the appointment].

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
