- 5 SECTION 1. Section 254.037, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 254.037. FILING DEADLINE. (a) Except as provided by
- 8 <u>Subsection (b), the [The]</u> deadline for filing a report required by
- 9 this chapter is 5 p.m. on the last day permitted under this chapter
- 10 for filing the report.
- 11 (b) The deadline for filing a report electronically with the
- 12 commission as required by this chapter is midnight on the last day
- 13 for filing the report.
- SECTION 2. Section 254.038(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (c) A report under this section shall be filed
- 17 electronically, by telegram or telephonic facsimile machine, or by
- 18 hand, in the form required by Section 254.036. The commission must
- 19 receive the report not later than midnight [5 p.m.] of the first
- 20 business day after the date the contribution is accepted. A report
- 21 under this section is not required to be accompanied by the
- 22 affidavit required under Section 254.036(h) or to be submitted on a
- 23 form prescribed by the commission. A report under this section that
- 24 complies with Section 254.036(a) must be accompanied by an

- 2 committee has submitted an affidavit under Section 254.036(c)(1)
- 3 with another report filed in connection with the election for which

- 5 SECTION 3. Section 302.015(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A statement required to be filed on the day before a
- 8 regular or called session convenes must actually be delivered and
- 9 in the possession of the Texas Ethics Commission not later than
- 10 $\underline{\text{midnight}}$ [5 p.m.] of that day.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 305.010, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 305.010. TIMELINESS OF FILING REGISTRATIONS AND
- 14 REPORTS. (a) A registration or report filed by first-class United
- 15 States mail or by common or contract carrier is timely if:
- 16 (1) it is properly addressed with postage or handling
- 17 charges prepaid; and
- 18 (2) it bears a post office cancellation mark or a
- 19 receipt mark from a common or contract carrier indicating a time
- 20 within the applicable filing period or before the applicable filing
- 21 deadline or if the person required to file furnishes satisfactory
- 22 proof that it was deposited in the mail or with a common or contract
- 23 carrier within that period or before that deadline.
- 24 (b) A registration or report filed by means of electronic
- 25 transfer is timely if it is received by the commission not later
- 26 than midnight on the last day permitted under this chapter for
- 27 filing the report or registration.

- 1 SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 571, Government Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 571.0645 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 571.0645. FILING DEADLINE FOR ELECTRONIC REPORTS. The
- 4 commission shall by rule establish that the deadline for any report
- 5 <u>filed electronically with the commission is midnight on the last</u>
- 6 day for filing the report under the law requiring the filing of the
- 7 report.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
