1-14	<u>municipalities [Two or more contiguous municipalities in the same</u>
1-15	county] may consolidate under one government in the manner provided

1-17	(1) two or more contiguous municipalities in the same
1-18	county; or
1-19	(2) two noncontiguous municipalities located in the
