A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to grants for higher education and workforce readiness
3 programs in public schools.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 29.917 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 29.917. HIGHER EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE READINESS
8 PROGRAMS. (a) From funds appropriated for the purpose, the
9 commissioner may award grants to organizations that provide
10 volunteers to teach classroom or after-school programs to enhance:

11 (1) college readiness;

12 (2) workforce readiness;

13 (3) dropout prevention; or

14 (4) personal financial literacy.

15 (b) To implement or administer a program under this section,
16 the commissioner may accept gifts, grants, and donations from
17 public or private entities.

18 (c) The commissioner may conduct a study of the programs
19 under this section to determine the success of the programs in
20 preparing students for higher education and participation in the
21 workforce.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
