7	Sec. 17.028. SERVICE ON FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS. (a) Ir
8	this section, "financial institution" has the meaning assigned by
9	Section 201.101, Finance Code.
10	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), in an action
11	against a financial institution, citation may be served by:
12	(1) serving the registered agent of the financial
13	institution; or
14	(2) if the financial institution does not have a
15	registered agent, serving the president or a branch manager at any
16	office located in this state.

- 17 (c) In an action against a credit union organized under the
- laws of this state, another state, or federal law, citation may be 18

- 4 SECTION 2. Section 32.202(a), Finance Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) Each state bank must have and continuously maintain in
- 7 this state a home office. The home office must be a location at
- 8 which the bank does business with the public and keeps its corporate
- 9 books and records. At least one officer of the bank must maintain
- 10 an office at the home office. [In addition to the registered agent
- 11 for the bank, if one is maintained pursuant to Section 201.103, each
- 12 officer at the home office is an agent for service of process for
- 13 the bank.
- SECTION 3. Section 182.202(b), Finance Code, is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act applies to all process served on a
- 16 financial institution on or after the effective date of this Act,
- 17 without regard to whether the process was issued before, on, or
- 18 after that date.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
