4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 42.008 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 42.008. SCHOOL FUNDING FORMULAS STUDY GROUP. (a) Ir
7	this section, "group" means the school funding formulas study
8	group.
9	(b) The commissioner shall establish a school funding
10	formulas study group as provided by this section. The group must
11	<pre>include:</pre>
12	(1) representatives of small, medium, and large school
13	campuses;
14	(2) representatives of urban, suburban, and rural
15	school districts;
16	(3) representatives of districts that are required to
17	take action under Chapter 41 and districts that are not required to
18	take such action; and
19	(4) one staff-level representative each of the
20	<u>following:</u>
21	(A) the office of the lieutenant governor,
22	designated by the lieutenant governor;
23	(B) the office of the speaker of the house of
24	representatives, designated by the speaker:

- 1 (C) the Senate Education Committee, designated
 2 by the chair of that committee; and
 3 (D) the House Committee on Public Education,
 4 designated by the chair of that committee.
 5 (c) The commissioner shall determine the number of group
 6 members. The commissioner may select a representative of a school
- members. The commissioner may select a representative of a school or school district to represent more than one interest described by Subsection (b)(1),(2), or (3).
- 9 (d) The group shall:
- 10 <u>(1) study the school funding formulas under Chapters</u>
 11 32 and 41 and this chapter; and
- 12 (2) make recommendations for simplifying the formulas
 13 described by Subdivision (1).
- 14 <u>(e) Agency staff shall provide technical assistance and</u>
 15 advice to the group.
- (f) Not later than November 1, 2008, the group shall submit to the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each member of the legislature a report that contains the group's recommendations under Subsection (d)(2).
- 20 (g) Chapter 2110, Government Code, other than Sections
 21 2110.002, 2110.004(b) and (c), 2110.006, and 2110.007, applies to
 22 the group.
- 23 (h) This section expires January 1, 2009.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
