- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 49.10(j), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (j) A justice of the peace may order a physician, qualified
- 9 technician, paramedic, chemist, registered professional nurse,
- 10 [or] licensed vocational nurse, funeral director, or embalmer to
- 11 take a specimen of blood from the body of a person who died as the
- 12 result of a motor vehicle accident if the justice determines that
- 13 circumstances indicate that the person may have been driving while
- 14 intoxicated.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
