4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 487, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter P to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER P. RURAL TECHNOLOGY CENTER GRANT PROGRAM
8	Sec. 487.701. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "rural
9	county" means a county that has a population of not more than
LO	125,000.
L1	Sec. 487.702. GRANT PROGRAM. (a) Subject to available
L2	funds, the office shall establish a grant program under which the
L3	office awards grants to public institutions of higher education,
L4	public high schools, and governmental entities located in a rural
L5	county for the development and operation of multi-institutional
L6	technology centers that provide:
L7	(1) community access to technology;
L8	(2) computer literacy programs;
L9	(3) educational programs designed to provide
20	concurrent enrollment credit for high school students taking
21	postsecondary courses in information and emerging technologies;
22	(4) training for careers in technology-related fields
23	and other highly skilled industries; and
24	(5) technology-related continuing and adult education

1	programs.
2	(b) The executive committee by rule shall establish:
3	(1) eligibility criteria for grant applicants;
4	(2) grant application procedures;
5	(3) guidelines relating to grant amounts;
6	(4) procedures for evaluating grant applications; and
7	(5) procedures for monitoring the use of grants
8	awarded under the program and for ensuring compliance with the
9	conditions of a grant.
10	Sec. 487.703. FUNDING. The office may seek, receive, and
11	spend money received through an appropriation, grant, donation, or
12	reimbursement from any public or private source to implement this
13	subchapter.
14	SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2007, the Office of
15	Rural Community Affairs shall establish the rural technology center
16	grant program required by Subchapter P, Chapter 487, Government
17	Code, as added by this Act, and shall award the first grants under
18	that program not later than January 1, 2008.
19	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
